

## How to find an eBook.

You can search for an eBook on the [ADF Library webpage](#) or on the ADF WorldCat [eBooks Browse A-Z](#) feature or in the [ADF WorldCat Discovery](#) search.

### Search on the ADF Library webpage.

1. Go to the [ADF Library webpage](#). Select the **Books** tab. Select **Title** if you are looking for a text or use **Subject** or **Keyword** to search. Insert your **search term** in the box for example, addiction. Select Search.

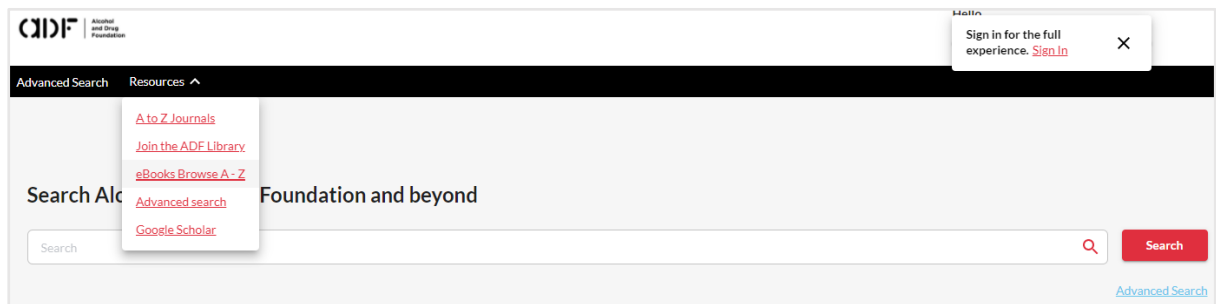

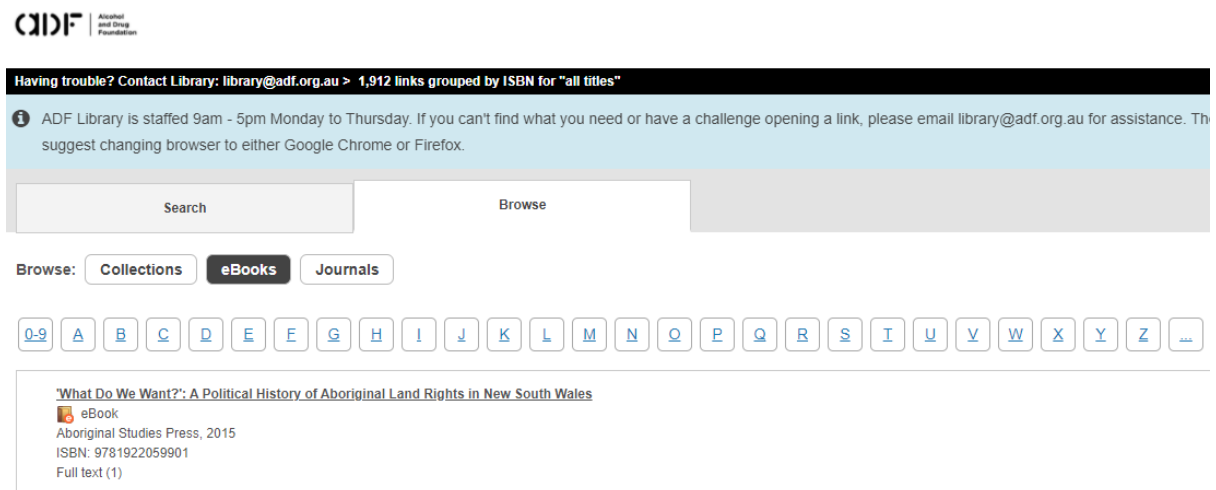

## Search via eBooks Browse A-Z.

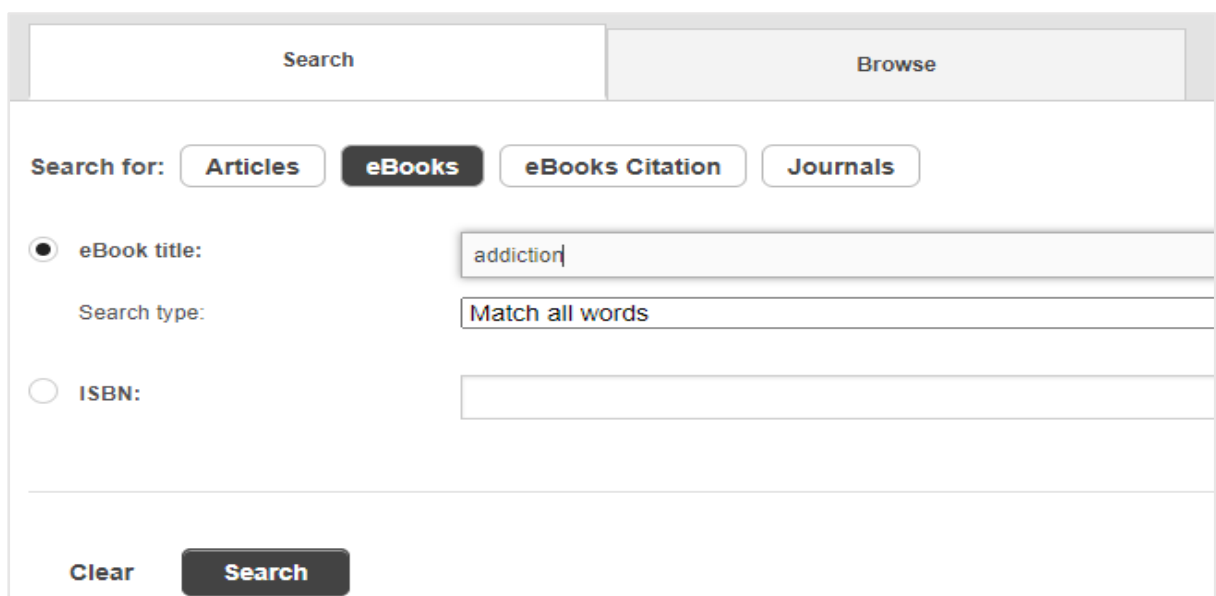
1. The best way to browse for eBooks is via the **eBooks Browse A-Z**, as found in the **Resources** option in the top menu.



2. Here you will find 1,912 eBook titles which you can **browse alphabetically** or select **Search**.



3. Here you can search by **title**. You can select to **Match all words**, exact words, or any words. Select **Search**.



4. This gives you a list of all the eBooks with ‘addiction’ in the title.



**Search for eBooks via ADF’s WorldCat Discovery.**

1. You can also go to the **ADF WorldCat search box** and insert your **search term** ‘addiction’ in the search box and select **Search**. It searches as a keyword unless otherwise selected.


