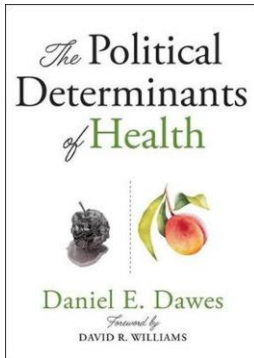


ADF Library Book Review.
